Feeding the Creative Process: Finding inspiration to write your awesome story

This workshop explores both new and tested techniques in finding inspiration in the most unlikely places, to help attendees write their own short stories.

Blog Writing Essentials: Starting and maintaining blogs

The sessions introduce attendees to the basics of blogging, with the intent of setting-up and managing their own blogs.

Found in Translation: Discover your skills in literary translation

This introductory workshop explores the craft of literary translation, providing attendees with a deeper understanding of the nuances and quirks of translating from one language to another.

Malay to English

1 short translated piece

Accepting My Own Words: Improving self-confidence through poetry

The session helps attendees to reflect on their self-awareness and esteem through poetic expressions.
